#### Introduction to Spanish

This course is designed to provide exposure to the Spanish language.

#### **Spanish for Fluent Speakers**

Designed for students who have native or near native oral fluency but have not yet mastered reading and writing skills.

- Not for high school credit



 Students needing additional support may be concurrently enrolled in Math 6, Math 7, or Pre-Algebra 8 along with an associated Strategies course.


## Math Placement for 23-24
